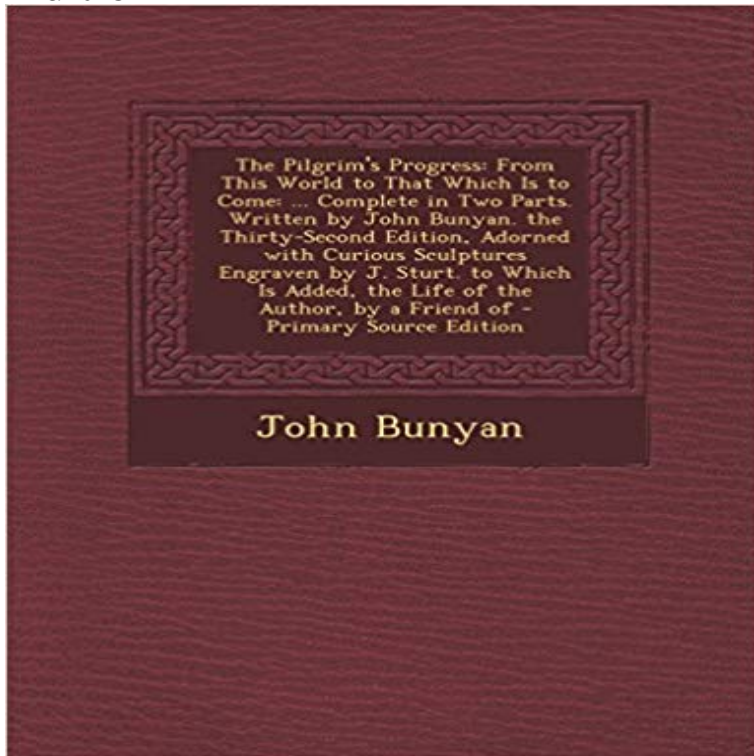


The Pilgrims Progress: From This World to That Which Is to Come: ... Complete in Two Parts. Written by John Bunyan. the Thirty-Second Edition
