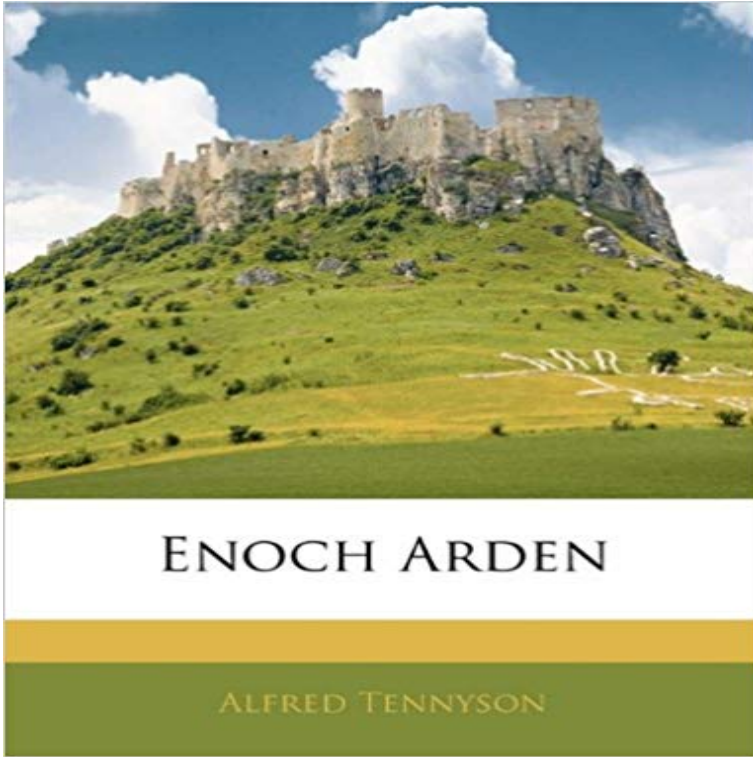


Enoch Arden
