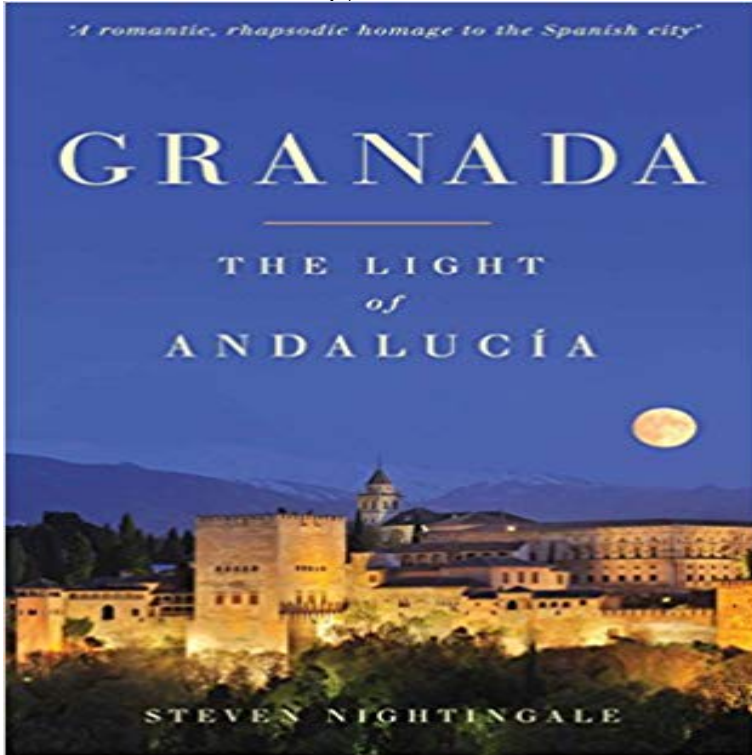


Granada: The Light of Andalucia
