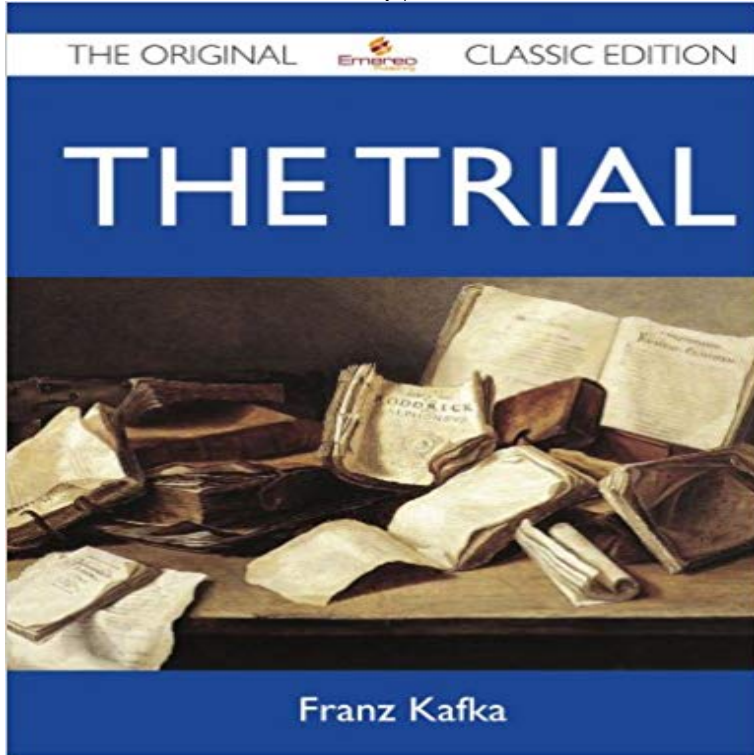


The Trial - The Original Classic Edition
